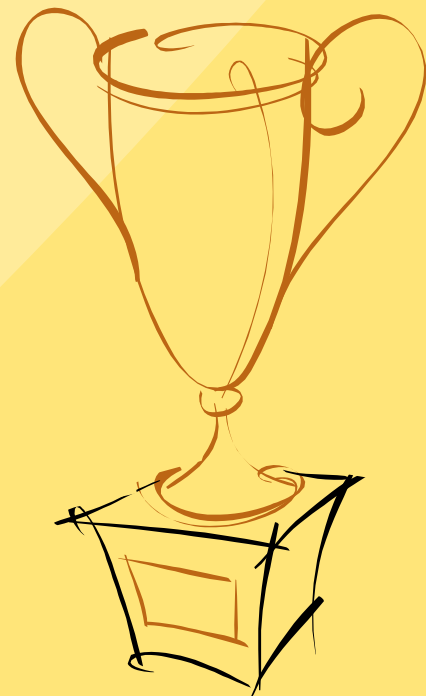


### HEADLINES
