Code of Conduct for Spectators

As Spectators we should all:-

- Applaud the opposition as well as our own team.
- Avoid coaching the player during the game.
- Not shout and scream
- Respect the Umpire's decision.
- Give attention to each of the player's involved in Cricket and not just the most talented.
- Give encouragement to everyone to participate in Cricket.
